A

The student provides a solution that demonstrates no understanding of the scope of the project, but contains some minimal work that would possibly lead to the correct solution.

The student provides an acceptable or correct solution, however, demonstrates little understanding of the strategy utilized in the supporting work.

F

The student does not provide a solution at all.

The student provides a solution (correct or incorrect) with no supporting work or explanation.

The student provides an acceptable or correct solution, however, demonstrates no understanding of the strategy utilized in the supporting work.
